**Subject: Disbursement of Pension/ Allowances under the EBT Scheme through Banks.**

I am sure you have gone through the detailed instructions on the subject cited above and circulated vide Memo No. 11117-37/SJE/EBT/2011 dated June 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2011 to all the Deputy Commissioners. In brief the following is reiterated:

1. That Permanent Enrolment Centres for enrolling new or left-out pensioners will be opened by the Business Correspondent (BC) of the Bank in each Block/ M.C. office of your district.
2. Additional enrolment teams will be provided to you by the BC this month for deployment in such villages/ wards, where it is felt by you to be necessary. This exercise is to be carried out by you under your direct supervision.
3. One Customer Service Point (CSP) will be established for every 700 account holders for operation of bank accounts by the pensioners. In case a single village does not have 700 number of account holders, the CSP will be established for a cluster of villages. In such cases, the schedule of operation of the CSP for each village in the cluster would be fixed. The days of the week would be assigned to each village in the cluster for CSP operation. The CSP will be operational on all bank working days of the month.

Please ensure this with the bank and its Business Correspondent. There would be a discussion on the implementation of the EBT Scheme in the next DC/SP conference.
